EVENTS and ENGAGEMENTS:

Due to the lockdown, the planned programmes for August – Oct in 2021 (musical evening end of August in collaboration with Sri Chinmoy organisation, and Exploring Sacred Spaces visits) were all cancelled. We were unable to organise Leadership Diversity Day this year due to instability and pressures in the school system. The Committee continued to meet regularly by Zoom to discuss any pertinent issues.

We are excited that the Exploring Sacred Spaces visits are scheduled to resume this year in Oct. Watch for notices on our email list, website, Facebook page, or via Auckland Heritage Festival promotion sites.

During the lockdown several Committee members were invited to speak in Zoom programmes organised by other organisations:

We were invited by the Department of Internal Affairs, Policy Division to engage with them about our perspective faith observations and experiences re "content and harm", content being any material available to the public. Members of the Committee volunteered their time and we had an evening hui on 23rd February 2022 which turned out to be well facilitated and interesting. The DIA was grateful for our contribution and gave a koha of \$500 to our organisation.

On 18 June Ruth was invited to be Guest Speaker at the Ahmadiyya Muslim Women's Association Interfaith Peace Symposium on the topic : Fundamentals of Establishing Lasting Peace in our Current Climate.
